

# Reflection... By Fr Jeronimo

#### SALVATION IS A GIFT TO ALL HUMANKIND

There is a question that is the heart in today's Gospel. "Lord, will there be only a few saved? that is the question that someone in the crowd ask Jesus, but the question he really ask is: "I will be save?

Lord is salvation for only a few select people. O does someone like me have a change?

To respond to this question the constitution Dei Verbum from the Vatican II we help us to understand this concept of Salvation.

Salvation is seen as a gift from God, revealed through Scripture and Tradition. The Dei Verbum emphasizes that God has chosen to make Himself known, which is essential for our understanding of Salvation.

Dei Verbum presents salvation as a comprehensive process rooted in God's revelation through Christ, mediated by the Church, and accessible to all who respond in faith.

Salvation is offered to all humanity, the document emphasizes God's desire for all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

I would like to finish this weekend my reflection with this beautiful prayer of Thomas Merton: "My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going, I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I really know myself. And the fact that I think that I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so.

But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you, and I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing.

I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire, and I know that if I do this, you will lead me by a right road though I may know nothing about it.

Therefore, will I trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone. amen




Dear Bedford Parish Community, due to unforeseen circumstances we apologized we had to postponed this event until further notice. Thank you & God Bless...



Second Reading from the letter to the Hebrews 12:5-7,11-13

Have you forgotten that encouraging text in which you are addressed as sons? My son, when the Lord corrects you, do not treat it lightly; but do not get discouraged when he reprimands you. For the Lord trains the ones that he loves and he punishes all those that he acknowledges as his sons. Suffering is part of your training; God is treating you as his sons. Then you will find yourself saying, "We once ate and drank in your company; you taught in our streets" but he will reply, "I do not know where you come from. Away from me, all you wicked men!" 'Then there will be weeping and grinding of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and yourselves turned outside. And men from east and west, from north and south, will come to take their places at the feast in the kingdom of God.
